

Guidelines for Dripping Springs Women's Club Scholarship

- **Deadlines/Completions:** Scholarship applications must be postmarked (United States Postal Service) by Tuesday, April 2, 2019. Applications postmarked after this date will not be accepted. Incomplete applications will not be considered for a scholarship award.
- Scholarship winners will be announced in May, 2019.
- In 2019, the DSWC Club will give two (2) scholarship awards in the amount of \$1000 each in honor of June Baumel and Susan Richardson.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Applicant must be a female high school student living within the boundaries of the Dripping Springs Independent School District. The scholarship award is open to home schooled students and those attending public and/or private high schools.
- All applicants must complete the application form and submit two letters of recommendation as outlined in the Application Instructions.
- Applicants must show proof of acceptance to an accredited institution of higher education before funds will be disbursed.
- An award will be based on merit, extracurricular activity, community participation and volunteerism, and writing ability (through answers to questions).
- The Dripping Springs Women's Club Scholarship Committee will review and rank the applications and make award recommendations to the Board of Directors of the Dripping Springs Women's Club.

Judging Criteria:

Applications will be judged on:

- Ability to express/write an idea
- Merit
- Extracurricular activity, community participation and volunteerism.

ATTACH copies of the following to the application:

1. Certified transcript (or equivalent)
2. Copies of ACT or SAT test score results
3. Letter(s) of acceptance from accredited institutions of higher education, if available.
4. Two letters of recommendation from non-family members. (See attached)
